PUEBLOS BLANCOS HIGHLIGHTS TOUR



Highlights: Views from “Puerto Las Palomas”. Zahara de la Sierra’s Arab Castle. Grazalema’s old quarter. Houses built into the rocks in Setenil de las Bodegas

The tour starts at your accommodation, going to Setenil de las Bodegas for a stroll through its picturesque streets. After a coffee the tour continues towards Grazalema. Once in the village, walking is the best way to discover the pretty white houses and the magnificent wrought iron hand – made balconies. The journey to Zahara de la Sierra the “Puerto de las Palomas” offers dramatic views of three provinces. As soon as you are in Zahara, if you feel comfortable you can climb up to the Arab Castle, it’s definitely worth it. The last stop before arriving in Ronda is for taking a wonderful picture (the lake, Zahara and the castle in one shot).

WALKING TOUR IN RONDA

This tour has been designed to let the visitors know how this town has been occupied from 2000 years B.C. to today. Its impressive cliff and gorge area was the reason why different cultures like Celts, Iberians, Romans, Visigoths and Arabs decided to live in this natural fort. The Arab period and the second half of 18th century were the most important times for the history of Ronda. The guide also will tell you wonderful stories that happened in the past, how that famous travellers during the last two centuries have fallen in love with this beautiful town. The stroll goes from the Bullring area across the New Bridge to the “La Ciudad” which is what local people call the old part of Ronda. Palaces, churches and beautiful squares will transport you to the past.

CULTURAL & WINE TASTING TOUR



Highlights: Cueva de la Pileta’s prehistoric paintings. Ruins Acinipo’s Roman Theatre. Tour and wine tasting at local winery

The tours starts at your accommodation and the first stop is the “Cueva del Gato”, a 45 km underground gallery that looks like the head of a cat. Different birds fly from inside. The next stop, “Cueva de la Pileta” is considered to be the most important prehistoric paintings place in the South of Spain. The guide will show you the secrets of its inhabitants during 36.000 years. The geological formations inside are as important as the paintings. Following history we arrive at Acinipo, the most important place in the area during the Roman Empire. A short stroll will take us to the Roman Theatre. Still nowadays its 2.500 seats make you feel how important this settlement was. Ending the tour, there is nothing better than visiting a local winery to meet the owners who strive daily to produce nice wines, especially the red ones. Obviously the tour ends with a tapas and wine tasting. Don’t worry about enjoying the wines, the guide will drop of at your accommodation.

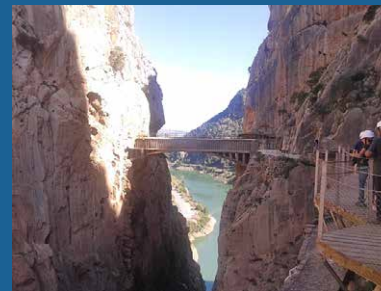
